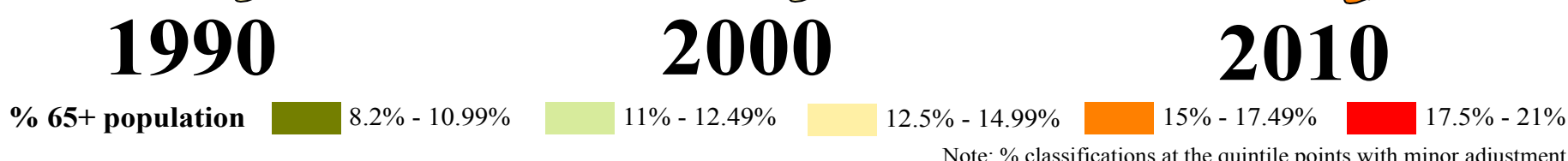
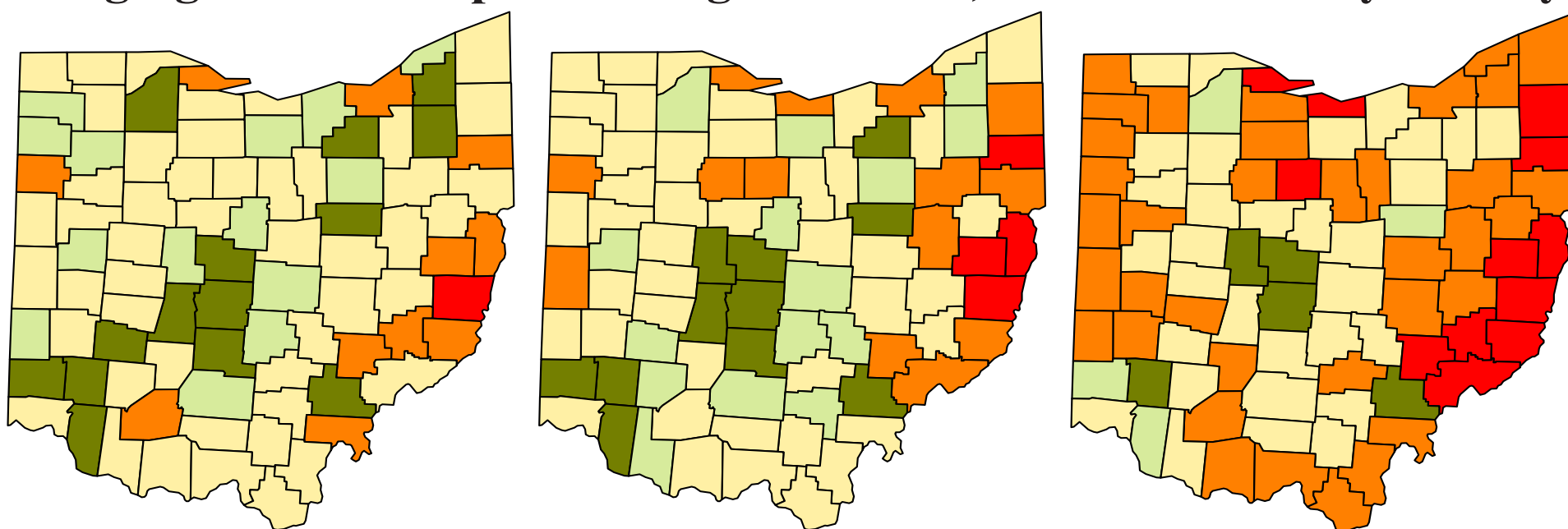

Resident Population: The resident population of a state includes all residents (both civilian and Armed Forces including military personnel on board military vessels with a U.S. homeport in that state) living in the state.

The 1990 information for Ohio and its 88 counties was taken from the 1990 U.S. Census of Population and Housing: Special Tabulation on Aging, Federal Region V: Ohio. The information is organized into categories based on census definitions.

The 2000 information for Ohio and its 88 counties was taken from Table DP-1. Profile of General Demographic Characteristics: 2000, and Table: 5-Year Age Groups by Race, Sex, and Hispanic Status for Ohio and Counties, 2000 Census (data as of 5/24/2001 & 6/15/2002 respectively).
