Upon completion, mail the application to USA Water Ski's Competition Department for processing. You should retain a copy of this application for your records. If you are filing for a one- or two-event rating, your application will be returned to you once your rating is approved along with current officials' program information. You should continue to complete the same application when working on other events.

Maintenance Requirements: Maintenance requirements for Judges and Scorers are based biennially (i.e., work performed January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2006 counts for renewal for 2007).

Attention Chief Judges/Chief Scorers: Please be discriminating. AWSA cannot maintain a high standard of scorers' qualifications unless you assume the responsibility of refusing to approve any but exceptionally qualified applicants.

Applicant must practice scoring under the **supervision of the Chief Scorer for a minimum of ten (10) skiers** for each requirement below. If the Chief Scorer feels that the applicant has not performed satisfactorily, credit should be withheld.
