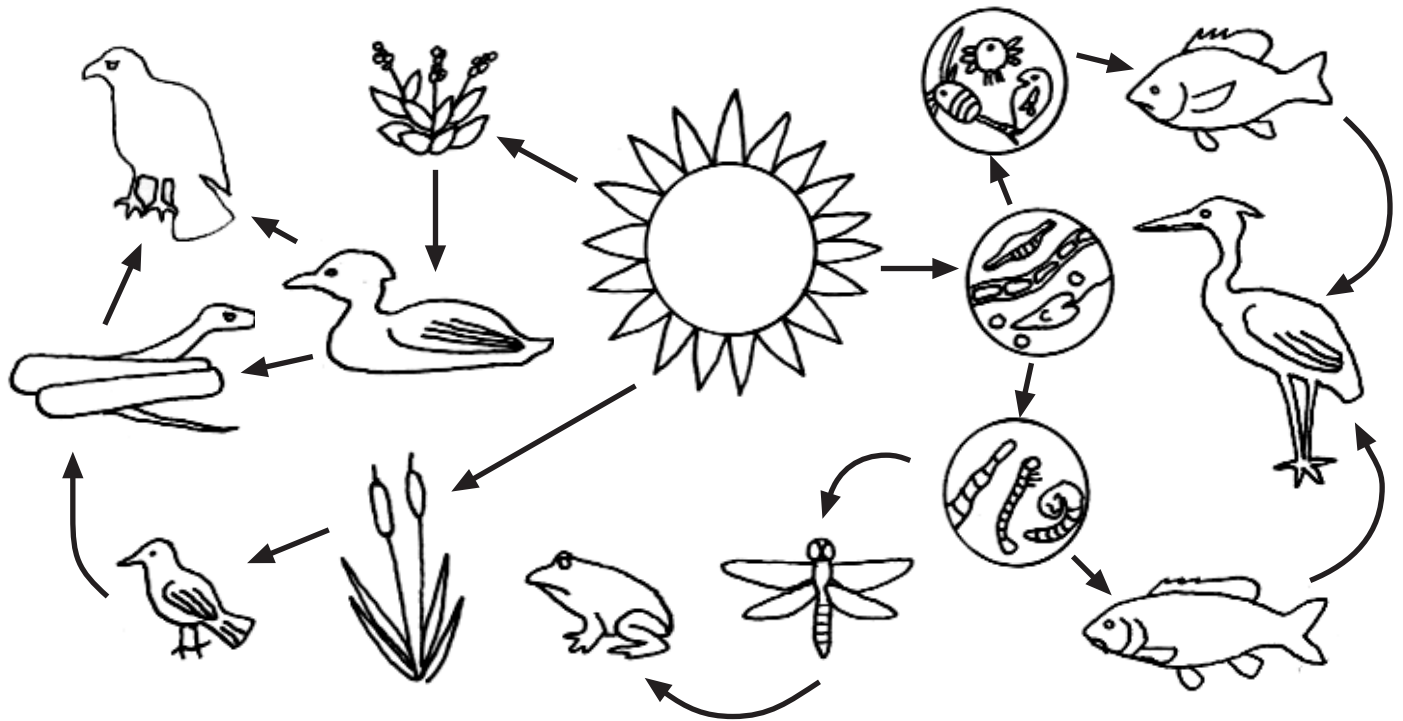




















The Pyramid of Energy and Food Webs
